Give & Gain Life With Kidney Transplantation

If you aren't a match for someone you care about who needs a kidney transplant or are an altruistic donor who does not have a recipient, there is still a way to help. **You could be part of a lifesaving program!** The Kidney Paired Donation (KPD) program may be able to provide another transplant opportunity.

Donors and recipients that are not a match may be entered in the Canadian Kidney Paired Donation Program. An advanced computer program finds multiple opportunities to exchange donors with different recipients around the country, to find pairs that are a good match with a very low chance of rejection. Willing, living donors without a specific intended recipient may also register in the Kidney Paired Donation program. These donors are able to start long 'domino' chains of transplants where one donor can trigger up to 6 transplants. These non-directed donors are responsible for more than two-thirds of the transplants in the Kidney Paired Donation program.
